## Ten simple rule for audition preparation

- 1. Cover the basics first: intonation, rhythm and sound
- 2. Build mental and physical relaxation and breathing into the excerpts
- 3. Your first play-through must be your BEST performance
- 4. You cannot hang onto technique; you can only hang onto the music (technique is only a vehicle)
- 5. You must trust that your body knows what to do TECHNICALLY and let go
- 6. Know the tempo of each excerpt cold BEFORE you play through
- 7. Take your time BETWEEN excerpts
- 8. Bring the orchestra on stage with you
- 9. It is never too early to mentally rehearse the entire audition process
- 10. Break in the excerpts with FREQUENT performances
